

## ***Parkwood National Historic Site Proof of Vaccination requirements***

Dear Friends of Parkwood,

In accordance with the new Provincial guidelines, effective September 22, 2021, any guest 12 and over seeking enter our facilities for an indoor photography session, a wedding or funeral reception or social gathering must show proof of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19, along with valid identification before the can enter the area, with limited exceptions,

An individual is fully vaccinated after they have received two does of an authorized Health Canada vaccine and received their final dose at least 14 days before providing proof of being fully vaccinated.

For a limited time, from September 22<sup>nd</sup> to October 12<sup>th</sup> when the Province of Ontario's QR code system is anticipated to take effect, guests also have the option to show proof of a negative antigen COVID-19 test result within the previous 48 hours to access our facilities.

To make your visit as smooth as possible, please be prepared to present proof of vaccination along with official government ID upon entry to Parkwood.

Please not that face masks and physical distancing measures remain in effect.
