The Museum

Can we just go into the house?

In order to see the (museum) you will need to book a tour. Pre-booking online is recommended in the event tours are full the date/time you (wish to visit)

Is the Auto Baron Tour (main floor entertaining spaces) appropriate for my child?

Yes, but it depends on the age, interests and activity level of your child, and you know them best. It is a tour where they will visit spaces like the indoor pool, squash court, billiard room etc. so if you think they would enjoy hearing about the history of the McLaughlin Family and seeing the home where they lived, please bring them along.

How much are tours? And how long are they?

Most tours are approximately 90 minutes, however the prices range depending on which tour you are taking. For exact pricing please visit the Plan a Visit Page.

Can we take photos/video on tour?

Guides will instruct you on what you can take photos of but video is not permitted.

Why don't you have the basement or private spaces tour throughout the year?

As a working museum, we require space for storage, work, and events, because of this we can only open certain spaces in the museum to public viewing at certain times. We do, however, offer several different specialty tours throughout the year

Are you open in the winter?

Tours and the Gift Shop are open for limited hours during the winter month. The outdoor property will remain closed until spring, when it is deemed safe to reopen.

The Grounds & Gardens

Do we have to pay to see the grounds/gardens?

No, entry to the 11-acre property, including the grounds and gardens, is free, but donations are always gratefully accepted.

Can we have a picnic?

Picnics are not permitted as we are not a public park. Having a snack while you are at Parkwood is permitted but full meals, baskets, chairs and blankets are not allowed.

Can I bring my dog to Parkwood?

Leashed and well-behaved dogs are welcome at Parkwood to walk the grounds and in the Gift Shop. You may also bring your dog to the Tea House, if your reservation is at one of the outdoor tables, and not inside the Tea House area.

Only certified service dogs are permitted inside the mansion.

Where are your washrooms located?

- Carriage House – accessible washrooms are available
- Public washrooms are located at the back of the parking lot near the back porch and the ramp

Accessibility

Are you accessible?

The main floor of the museum is accessible for wheelchairs, walkers and small umbrella strollers. Accessible washrooms are available in our Carriage House next to the Gift Shop. The beautiful 11-acre garden has a variety of terrains, including paved paths, flagstone, gravel and grass. The formal garden fountain has gravel pathways. If you have a reservation at the Tea House, a golf cart is available to transport you to and from the Tea House for those with mobility issues and can be requested in the Gift Shop.

Weddings/Photos/Proposals

Can I propose at Parkwood?

Yes, this is a very romantic place to propose amongst the beautiful 11-acre garden. There are many little nooks that will feel like you're in a private oasis.

Can we take photos?

Casual photos are allowed, but if you are working with a professional (photographer/equipment) camera and set up we require you to purchase a photography permit. Do you host events?

Yes, as a charitable organization we host approximately 160 events throughout the year as a way to raise funds to support the museum. Continue to visit our website for the ever-changing options.

The Restaurant (Tea House)

Can we buy food at Parkwood?

There is a vending machine available in the Carriage House, where the gift shop is located. During the summer months our outdoor restaurant, the Tea House serves lunch and afternoon tea daily, and dinner Thursday and Friday evenings.

Where is the Tea House? Can we just purchase food while there?

The Tea House is located at the west end of the property by the 200 ft fountain. It is open daily from June to September – weather permitting. While walk-ins may be available, reservations are recommended. Also, due to the nature of our property, and the 5-minute walk from the parking lot to the Tea House, please ensure you wear appropriate footwear.

Parking & Directions

Do you have Parking?

Yes, (on site) parking is free but very limited for Parkwood guests. There is a paid parking garage (located on the west side of the estate)

How do we get there?

Parkwood is accessible by car, cab/uber or bus, and is located at 270 Simcoe Street North, on the corner of Adelaide Avenue and Simcoe Street. The main entrance is located on the west side of Simcoe Street, between Adelaide Avenue and Hospital Court

Where are the bus stops located in proximity to Parkwood?

- Simcoe Northbound @ Hillcroft is 293 meters away, 4 min walk. (Located in front of O’Neill Highschool)
- Adelaide Westbound @ Simcoe is 522 meters away, 7 min walk.
- Simcoe St. N. @ Parkwood Crt. is 933 meters away, 12 min walk.(located on the west side of Simcoe Street in front of Lakeridge Health Hospital)

Which bus lines stop near Parkwood?

According to DRT the bus lines that stop near Parkwood are 405,56, 901.
